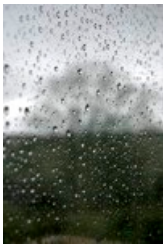

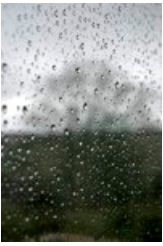
Skittles League Matches

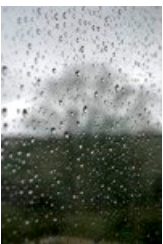
Skittles League Fixtures

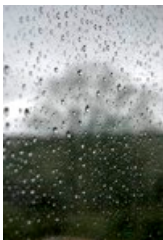
