Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting 1/2/2022

PUBLIC FORUM

There were 2 members of the public present.

Mrs West thanked the Council for supporting the application for the creation of holiday units at the Weary Friar.

County Councillor Daw raised the issue of traffic speed. It was recognised that enforcement was difficult but the suggestion of recording delivery van numbers and complaining to the firm involved was welcomed.

MINUTES

The minutes of 4th January 2022 Council meeting were accepted unanimously after inserting the sentence < The Neighbourhood Plan was rejected because such a Plan was considered not appropriate to the Village and the cost was excessive>.

The Council agreed that minutes relating to significant matters should include reasons for acceptance or rejection.

MATTERS ARISING

PLAY PARK

Cllr Johnson informed the meeting that a grant of £9,000 had been secured from the Solar Farm fund and together with other sources the target of £16,000 was within reach. Parishioners were urged to donate to the scheme.

The Council supported the raising of a contract by the Play Park Committee to purchase the equipment when the necessary funds had been obtained and a contractor chosen.

PLANNING APPLICATIONS none.

INCREASE IN BRIDGE AND FERRY TOLLS

The Council urged the public to object individually to the proposed increase as the construction and maintenance of highways and bridges throughout the Country was met by central government with the Tamar Crossings being unfairly excluded.

PAYMENTS

The Council agreed the following payment; £1,408.16 to Cornwall Council for election costs.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

The Chairman reported that as a result of safety checks at the playing field some posts and timbers required repairing and the Council approved a quotation of £90 to carry out the repairs.

Councillor Warne sought advice as to the positioning of slow signs for which he would seek the installation via the local CNA .
