Also of Mary, wife of the above. She departed this life the 31st day of October 1825, aged 69 years.

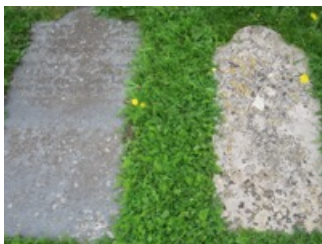
Weep not for me my children dear

And also Richard their son who was buried January 27th 1767, Aged 23 years

## **Littlejohn, William & Joan [218]**

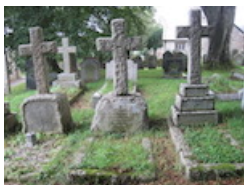
## **Lucas, George Grant [124]**

## Mason, James & Philley [36]



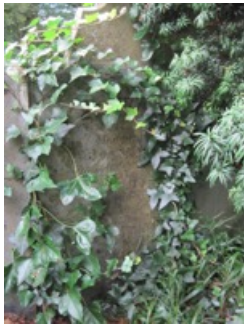
In loving memory of James Mason, who died at Marsh Gate, St. Ive, April 22nd 1867, aged 46 years.

[11X does not figure in Roman numerals up to 20: I think 11X means 2 months from 10, ie. aged 8 months . . . Ed.]

'Christ knocks for me  
To Him above all other,  
I will forsake my parents dear  
Weep not for me dear mother'.

### **Metherell, John & Margaret [93]**



Sacred to the memory of John Metherell who died the 4th day of June 1818, aged 80 years.

On his left side, lieth his Wife Margaret and 5 Children.

### **Moore, George Henry & Gertrude D. M. [163]**



In loving memory of George Henry Moore, died Feb. 1st. 1950, aged 54 years.

Also, his wife, Gertrude D.M. Moore, died May 22nd 1976, aged 84 years.

### **Moss, Henry Norman & Frances Mary & Richard W. H. [177]**

## Smith, Grace [205]



Grace ye daughr. of James Smith Junr: she was here Buried Janry. ye 1st 1743/2 aged 3 years 6 months 2 weeks.

‘Remember Death’.

[Note: This memorial is recorded as being located ‘to the right of the Church front door’ and is listed as being ‘a free standing door’. This is obviously an error: It is meant to read ‘a free standing stone’.]

(NB. The date is recorded on the stone as 1742 with the 3 sitting over the 2 separated by a horizontal bar. This is most likely in recognition of the Old Style and New Style dates whereby from around 1190 until 1751 the year started on Lady Day (25th March) and ended on 24th March twelve months later. Hence January 1st was still in the “previous” year of 1742 (Old Style) but in 1743 (New Style). From 1752 the New Style date was formalised but leading up to that time records sometimes show both years, as here. This stone has now been mounted on the outside wall to the right of the main door.)

## Smith, James & Elizabeth [38]



Here lies the body of James Smith of this Parish who died the 20th (?) day of April A.D. 177(9) aged 78 years.

Also, Elizabeth, his wife who died the 2nd September A.D. 1787, aged 77 years.

‘This couple sleep here in the Dust  
In hopes in Heav’n to meet the Just  
At the great Judgement Day.  
Wherever Reader thou dost dwell  
Night and day strive to excel’.

To the memory of John Smith of this Parish who died the 28th day of March 18--, aged 78 years.

Note from investigator:

This stone was snapped off and was covered in weeds and had a slowworm tucked in behind the broken slate.

(NB. There is no sign of the stone in the position indicated on the sketch map but [62] is not far away and seems to have some similarity. Burial records show a John Smith (aged 78) buried on March 31st 1818)

Underneath Lie the Remains of Robert Smith of this Parish Who departed this Life the 7th day of October 1815, Aged 43 Years:

Also the Remains of James, son of the above Robert Smith and Frances, his Wife, who departed this Life the 9th day of November 1810, Aged 2 Yrs and 11 Mths.

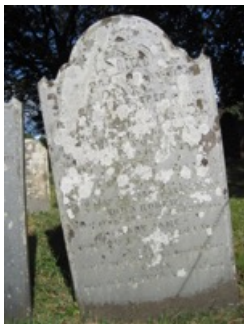

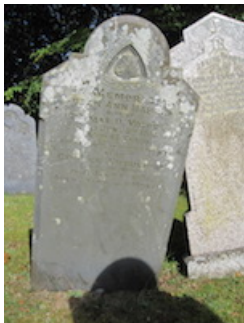
