ANY OTHER BUSINESS

The Council was informed that Cllr Harris's application to join a South East Cornwall working group to promote economic issues in the area had been successful.

The Council debated the problem of people using the playing field allowing dogs on the field despite the signs saying no dogs. It was recognised that the Council had no legal power to prevent dogs on the field and that all that could be done was to ask people with dogs to leave the field.
