July Rainfall



There was only 6mm (0.24") of rain in July making it the driest month since our records began back in 2011. This was marginally lower than the September 2014 total of 6.5mm.

The total rainfall for the seven months so far in 2022 is 433mm (17.05") and is considerably lower than the previous lowest over a corresponding period in 2011 of 555mm (21.85"). By contrast, in the first seven months of 2021 we had 930mm (36.61") of rain although the latter half of the year then proved drier than average.


