Minutes of the Parish Council Meeting 4/7/2023

PUBLIC FORUM

There were 3 members of the public present.

MINUTES

The minutes of 6<sup>th</sup> June 2023 Council meeting were accepted unanimously.

MATTERS ARISING

a) COMMEMORATION TREE

Following a site inspection by the forest of Cornwall Project Office and Cornwall Highways, the Council agreed to the planting of a Rowan tree near the seat adjacent to Dolcoath.

The Council also agreed to sign a Cornwall Highways licence form and to payment for a bag of mulch for the rowan tree.

b) TELEPHONE BOX PAINTING

Cllr Dolley volunteered to contact the painter to pursue completion of the exterior and to quote for some decoration of the interior.

PLANNING APPLICATION

OVERGROWN VERGE NEXT TO DOLCOATH

In view of the potential hazard caused by poor traffic visibility, it was agreed that the Clerk would contact Cornwall Highways to request cutting of the verge.

INSTALLATION OF SPEED CAMERA

Having received concerns from parishioners regarding the speed of vehicles through the village, Councillor Johnson proposed investigating the feasibility and costs of installing a speed camera near the Church and playing field. The proposal was agreed on the casting vote of the Chair.

FINANCE

In the absence of the Clerk, finance was deferred to the next meeting.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Councillor Floyd reported that the vegetation at Tiddlers Well was overgrown and a potential traffic hazard. The Chair agreed to discuss the situation with the owner of the land.
